A few times in a generation we are privileged to live with a person uniquely in charge of his own life. Because of this self-sufficiency he is able to orchestrate other lives. Such a person was Brother George Edward Meares. He was busy in nation-wide social, fraternal and religious programs throughout his life. Brother Meares' participation in rehabilitation programs, as a finely trained social worker, had a significant impact in New York State. His heart must have been warmed by Brother Earl Graves' statement on the occasion of accepting Omega's Citizen of the Year Award at the 1974 Conclave.

It would not be fair to come to this platform and say anything about Omega and not mention George Meares... a person who has been very much instrumental in much of what it is that I have accomplished as a Brother in Omega and likewise as a youth growing up in Bedford-Stuyvesant....

Brother Meares' expertise as Grand Basileus from 1964 to 1967 still evokes admiration from those who were fortunate enough to observe masterful presiding. His legacy of love and concern includes another first: Mrs. Georgia J. Meares, his widow, established the George Meares Memorial Scholarship Fund because of her loving memory of his concern for the education of young people. The base amount of this fund is the largest amount the fraternity has been privileged to administer.

The Fifty-seventh Conclave of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity pays reverent tribute to the memory of Brother George Edward Meares.

Brother Mifflin T. Gibbs and several succeeding DR's. He was a charter member of the 2nd District Conference.

In 1948 he was appointed by then Grand Basileus Brother D. Harry Penn as general chairman of the reorganization committee which founded the office of National Executive Secretary of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. He was also one of the charter members of the Century Club who donated the first one hundred dollars for the building of the National Headquarters on Georgia Avenue in the Nation's Capital.

In 1961, Brother Burrell was among the first Brothers to receive the 40 Year Award at the 50th Anniversary of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. in Washington, D.C. And, after moving to St. Albans, Queens, New York, he joined Nu Omicron Chapter on Long Island while retiring that same year from the Courts of New York as Senior Probation Officer. In 1969 he was elected the most Outstanding Omega Man, par excellence, for all times by Nu Omicron Chapter.

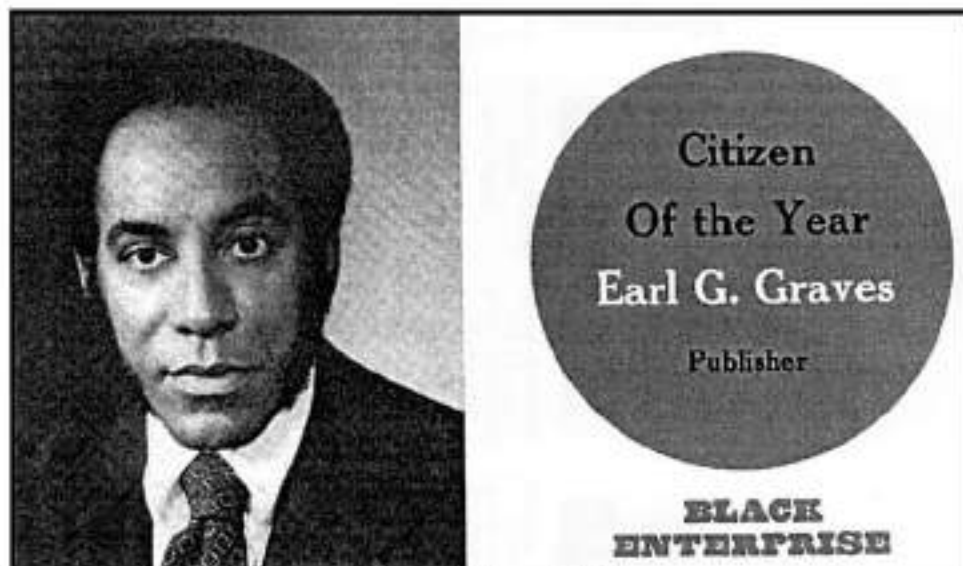

Brother James S. Avery was elected in 1963 to the position, First Vice District Representative with Brother Dr. Edward W. Waters elected as the District Representative. Due to Brother Waters' assignment to western Nigeria as a member of UNESCO, Brother Avery became the Acting District Representative in January 1964. He was subsequently elected and reelected, completing his tenure in 1967.

During his Annual Message to the 2nd District Conference in 1964, Brother Avery made reference to Marcus Aurelius as one of the wisest men who ever lived. He quoted Aurelius as saying, "A man's life is what his thoughts make it." Brother Avery went on in addressing the brotherhood saying, "A man is literally, what he thinks he is. Change his thoughts and you change his world. What Aurelius said so many years ago can be paraphrased to make good sense for us in Omega. A brother's life in Omega is what his thoughts of Omega make it. If he sees it as a fraternity for the occasional reunion of good college men, that's all it will be. If he thinks of it as a fraternity truly based upon the ideals of manhood, perseverance, scholarship and uplift, then and only then will his whole concept of Omega become to him, something of value. And, he'll work to keep it that way. So will we, if we love Omega, as we say we do."

In the September 1965 at the direction of Brother Avery, the first Second District Shirtsleeve Conference was held in Princeton, New Jersey. This was a special conference, the first of its kind where brothers were informed that serious matters pertaining to the future life of Omega would be discussed. Thirty-four brothers representing 13 chapters convened on Saturday morning, September 10, 1965 for the start of this historic meeting.

The success of the shirtsleeve conference concept in the Second District was in major part, the catalyst for the Fraternity's conduct of the Leadership Conference. Brother Avery's dynamic leadership as District Representative led to his becoming First Vice Grand Basileus and then the 27th Grand Basileus.

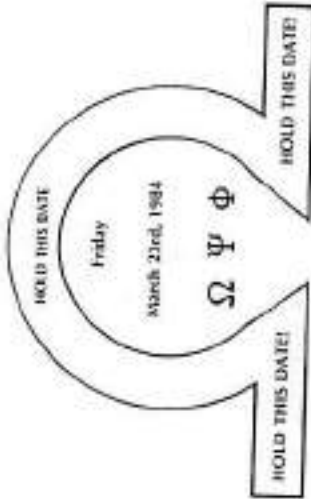

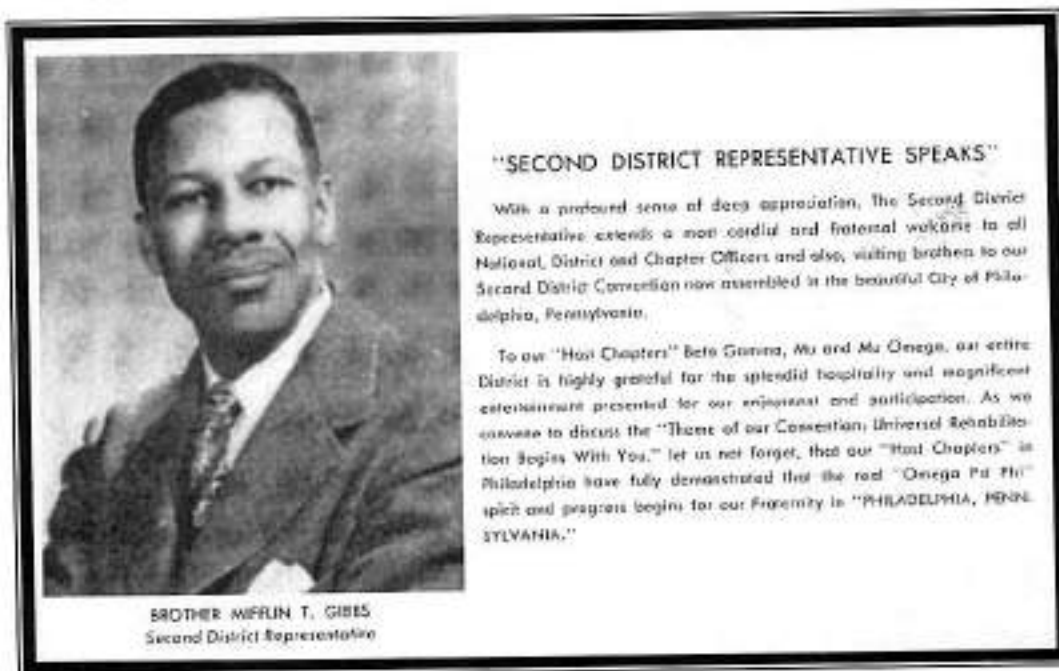

He attended Florida A&M, Howard University and Temple Law School. Brother Gibbs was initiated into Omega Psi Phi Fraternity on March 4, 1919 at Howard University. He became known as the "Father of the 2nd District Conference."

Among the many traits exhibited by Brother Gibbs was that he loved to write, especially in his corresponding about the affairs of his Fraternity. The archives of Omega contain many files of very significant correspondence written by this dedicated brother who loved our Fraternity.

- Basileus Epsilon Chapter 1934 - 1949
- Co-Founder of Show Boat, Epsilon Chapter, 1934
- 1st Vice Grand Basileus 1939 -1944
- Second District Representative 1945 - 1950
- Set up reorganization of 2nd District in 1947 (From 3 to 5 states)
- Served as Basileus of Mu Omega Chapter

Brother Gibbs was very active in the YMCA, Urban League, civic and community affairs.

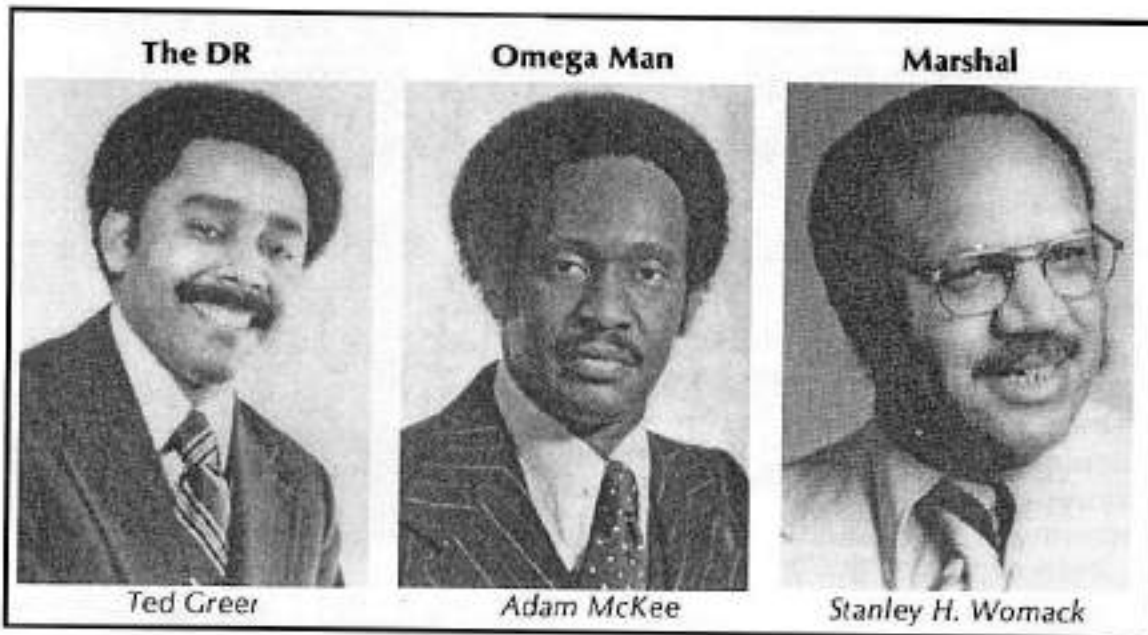

**1986-1988** Brother Doctor Andrew A. Ray was the 20<sup>th</sup> Second District Representative assuming office in April 1986. Under the leadership of Brother Ray, the assets of the Second District were nearly doubled during his tenure from \$39k to \$77k. As one of the more financially endowed Districts in the Fraternity, the Second District provided funds to establish the Omega Psi Phi Credit Union. During 1996, District enrollment grew from 1300 to 1900 financial brothers with District Conference registration increasing by well over 100 percent. During this period, the emphasis on scholarship and social actions increased to new heights, with funding for these two focus programs being quadrupled.

**1988-1990** "Run Dicky Run" were the buzz words echoing throughout the corridors and executive suites of the Pittsburgh Hilton Hotel as the Brothers of the Second District conducted their business at the 40<sup>th</sup> Second District Conference in May 1988. Brother Richard H. Johnson, Jr. ran on a platform to improve the Selection and Education Program, to improve the communication system within the District and to continue the tradition that the "Second is First."

In Brother Johnson's "State of the District" address in 1990, he issued the following to the leaders of our fraternity of the future, "I challenge you my younger brothers to envision yourselves in the future, 10-to-20 years from today not only in the light of Omega but in your chosen professions, your church work, your community work and political activities." He went on by directing comments to the established brothers saying, "We need to act as big brothers to our younger brothers and not as father-to-son. We need not chastise so much but to put our collective arms around a younger brother to encourage him and to let him know we are there to help and assist and to guide. By doing this we are protecting our future, the future of Omega. These younger brothers are not only the future of Omega but the future of this country and the world."

**1992-1994** Brother David B. Wharton, Sr., cites the following as the highlights of his tenure as Second District Representative:

- Historic Mu Chapter on the campus of the University of Pennsylvania was reactivated.
- The first group of brothers from the United States Military Academy at West Point were inducted into the Fraternity.
- Phi Kappa Chapter, Bridgeton, New Jersey was chartered.
- The 100<sup>th</sup> birthday of the late Brother Theodore "Beta 16" Randolph was recognized through the presentation of a plaque from the brothers of the Second District.
- Brother Wharton represented the Second District Conference at the dedication ceremony for the H. Carl Moultrie Building in the Nation's Capital.
- A five-year suspension was imposed on Chi Chapter at the University of Maryland, College Park for hazing.
- Kappa Eta Chapter, Seton Hall University, South Orange, New Jersey was reactivated.

## Superintendent Baltimore City Public School System

*Baltimore, June 1991.* Brother Dr. Walter G. Amprey was appointed to head one of the largest public school systems in the United States. Brother Amprey was recognized by Grand Basileus C. Tyrone Gilmore for his appointment and also by Kurt L. Schmoke, Mayor of Baltimore, Maryland. In an interview with Brother James T. Dixon, Sr., Brother Amprey said, "I have been so overwhelmed positively by many well wishers. People, particularly those in the Baltimore community who seem to be pleased by my appointment by the Board of Education. They generally wish me well and want to see me succeed." Brother Amprey has served the Second District in many capacities including being the District Representative and the Grand Keeper of Records and Seal.

## "Age of Technology and Return to Youth"

**1996-1998.** This two-year period of the Second District can be described as the "age of technology and a return to youth." In 1997, the Second District launched its World Wide Web site and held a very successful information technology workshop at the Shirtsleeve and the 49th Second District Conferences. The movement toward information technology applications also led to locating the District headquarters for information and support in Philadelphia. In addition to web site development, many brothers began to communicate via E-mail, thereby increasing to a large measure, verbal exchanges formerly conducted using normal telephone and postal services.

The administration of Brother Michael A. Freeman, Ph.D., also made the affairs of undergraduate members a high priority. Even though an internationally imposed membership moratorium curtailed induction activities, several undergraduate chapters were revived in 1997. Phi Kappa at Rowan College, Kappa at Syracuse University, Nu at Pennsylvania State University, Beta Kappa at Frostburg State University, and Kappa Eta at Seton Hall University were all chapters which were revived.

The Second Vice District Representative was included and instrumental in the conduct of all matters related to District operations. His presiding over parts of all District meetings is believed to have been a major contributor and influence to the increased participation among undergraduates in the District communication organ, social action projects and committee. District sponsorship of undergraduates to the International Undergraduate Summit proved to be useful in encouraging dialogue among senior and younger brothers throughout the Fraternity.

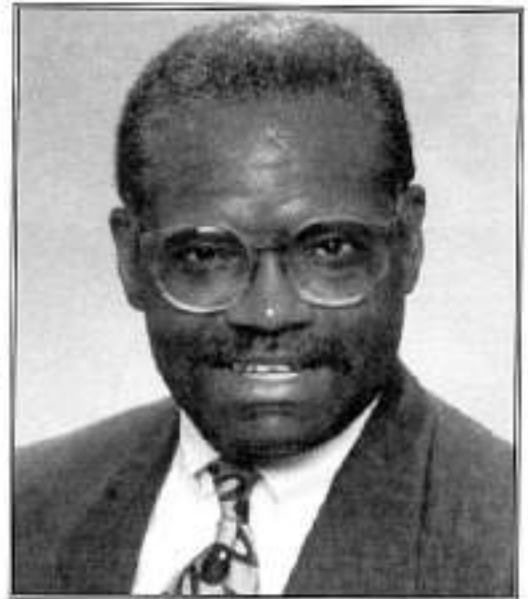

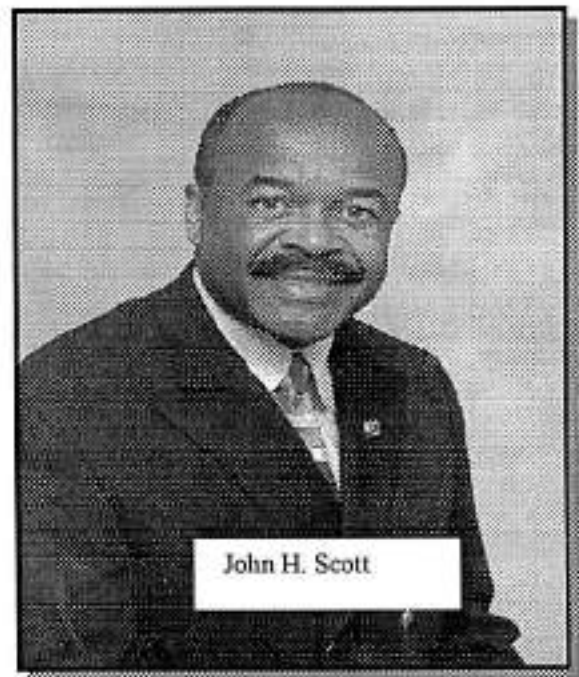

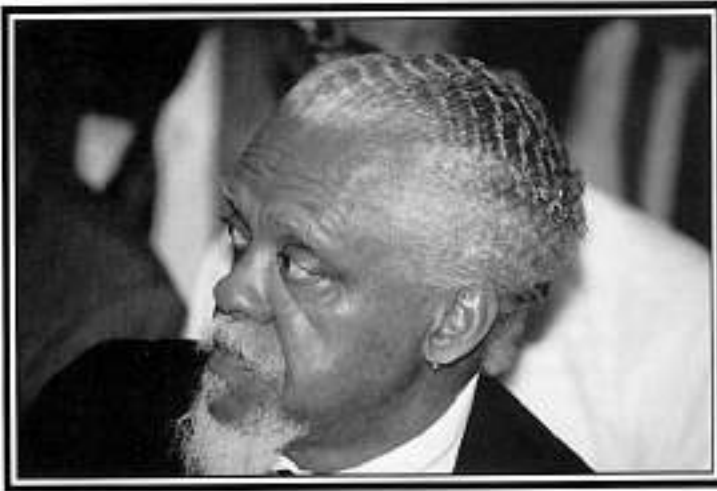
